Resident introduces the Cadre Collection by ASCA Studio

Resident is thrilled to introduce the Cadre Chair and Cadre Stool by Copenhagen-based studio ASCA. The collaboration marks ASCA's debut with the brand, further expanding Resident's portfolio of thoughtful, enduring furniture.

Crafted with a slender aluminium frame, available in brushed aluminium or dark bronze powder-coated finishes, the Cadre Chair and Stool pair geometric precision with subtle warmth. A defining horizontal bar aligns with the edge of the table, creating a clean visual connection while serving as a practical handle. The upholstered seats contrast softness against the frame's solid structure, designed for comfort during extended use. The seat appears to float above the frame with hidden fixings and a distinctive negative space between the seat and base adding lightness to the form and emphasising the architectural clarity of each piece.

Co-founded by Cassandra Bradfield and Sofia Olsson, ASCA operates at the intersection of interiors and product design. Their approach is deeply intuitive, balancing form, texture and tone to create pieces that feel both grounded and elevated.

“We set out to design a dining chair that offers high comfort without compromising on character — something that could be repeated along long tables and still make a visual impact, especially when seen from the back. The horizontal bar was designed to align with the table edge, creating a clean visual dialogue while also serving a functional purpose as a handle.”

The Cadre Collection's versatility makes it suited to a variety of interiors, from classic to contemporary, with design and craftsmanship built to evolve over time.
