Resident Introduces the Sacha Chair in Kvadrat Regos Upholstery.

Resident expands the expression of its iconic Sacha Chair by Philippe Malouin with the introduction of a new upholstery option: Regos by Kvadrat. Defined by its distinctive silhouette and graphic character, the addition of Regos brings a fresh tactile dimension to one of Resident's most recognisable seating designs.

Designed by Patricia Urquiola for Kvadrat, Regos is a knitted upholstery textile crafted in the Netherlands using locally produced filling yarn, primarily derived from Kvadrat Febrik's own post-industrial waste. The textile explores the language of natural textures and the codification of textile techniques, creating a richly layered surface with depth and character. Its name derives from "regolith", the loose, heterogeneous layer that covers solid bedrock, drawing inspiration from the textured terrain of the lunar surface.

The interplay between Sacha's sculptural geometry and Rego's tonal complexity introduces a new softness to the chair's architectural form. Layered textures and subtle contrasts enrich the visual language of the piece while reinforcing its comfort and versatility across residential, hospitality, and workplace settings.

"The Sacha Chair is visually graphic, brutal and geometric. We were drawn to Regos because of its layered textures and contrasting tonal pattern - qualities that extend the personality of Sacha while further emphasising its comfort and versatility," says Resident Founder, Scott Bridgens.

Now with an even more tactile expression, Sacha continues to evolve - equally suited to dining spaces, meeting rooms, and interiors seeking both character and refinement.
